This presentation will review assessment of eating disorders and dietetic and psychological treatment of eating disorder in athletes of diverse identities. Presenters will specifically address the epidemiology of eating disorders in athletes of all gender identities and ages, the prevalence of specific eating disorders across racial and ethnic identities in different types of sport, and the nutritional needs of athletes in different sports based on gender identity and age.

Objectives:

- Describe the benefits of a team approach in treating student athletes diagnosed with eating disorders.
- Explore athlete identity and its role in the prevention, treatment and recovery process of athletes diagnosed with eating disorders.
- Identify mechanisms that maintain eating disorders within the athletic environment and ways treatment professionals can support athletes in their recovery.
